- **Julia Jones, violin** — Prize winner of the 2026 Elevar Foundation / EOIVC Competition, performing Brahms' *Double Concerto* alongside cellist Elliott Sloss.
- **Elliott Sloss, cello** — 2026 College Division Winner of the Adelphi Orchestra Young Artist Competition, joining Julia Jones in Brahms' powerful masterpiece.

Our season extends far beyond the concert hall. We are proud to collaborate with the Ars Musica Chorale, provide live music for Ballet Arts of NJ's *Nutcracker*, and offer free Adelphi Chamber Ensemble performances at public libraries—ensuring that world-class music remains accessible to all.

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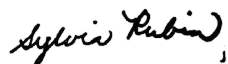
